Bio / Admin. History: The first indoor curling rink in Millet, Alberta was constructed in 1925, and the sport immediately became popular among both women and men. The Millet Ladies' Curling Club was apparently established shortly afterward. In 1968 Millet's second curling rink was damaged by a windstorm and was then demolished. The Club apparently disbanded at that time.
