Dates: 1917-1967

Phys. desc.: 20 cm of textual records and other material.

Bio-Admin. History: In 1912 a Mothers' Club was formed by a group of women in the

West Liberty district near Millet. In 1917 they decided to affiliate with the Alberta Women's Institutes and were chartered as the Millet Women's Institute. Women's Institutes, a predominantly rural movement, were dedicated to domestic life and community improvement. In 1922 the Millet Women's Institute built a meeting hall with a rest room (drop-in centre) for women visiting the village. In 1938 the hall was sold and a house was purchased instead. In 1953 the group cooperated with neighboring Women's

Institutes to establish Millet's first community library. The Millet

Women's Institute disbanded in 1967.

Custodial History: The fonds was donated to the Millet and District Historical Society

by Irene Nelson, a former member of the Millet Women's Institute, in 1986. Mary McNaughton donated some records in 2001 and a

further donation of material was made in 2003 by Dorothy

Wotherspoon.

Scope/ Content: The fonds consists of the Charter of the Millet Women's Institute,

minute books, financial records, correspondence, resource books

for the cub troop sponsored by the WI, photographs and

miscellaneous materials. The archivist has supplied some file titles.
