Bio / Admin. History: Rebekah Lodges are women's fraternal organizations associated

with the Independent Order of Odd Fellows. Started initially in England the orders came to the new world in the early 1800s with the American pilgrims and into western Canada about 1889. They seek to improve the lives of especially widows and orphans, the aged and the young. One branch of the Rebekahs was formed in the Millet area in 1910 and they joined with other Alberta groups to form an Assembly. The Sunbeam Rebekah Lodge No. 112 was organized in Millet, Alberta in 1931 (or it may be a reformed and renamed version of the earlier group). It has contributed to

numerous charitable causes in Millet and elsewhere. It disbanded

in 1997.

Custodial History: The material was donated to the Millet and District Historical

Society by the Rebekah Lodge in 1997 and from Dorothy

Wotherspoon in 1998.

Scope / Content: The fonds consists of a photocopied membership register, roll call

books, correspondence, certificates, financial reports, photographs, and printed materials. It also includes correspondence (1933-1943) and other materials of the Millet Lodge No. 145 of the Independent

Order of Odd Fellows. Titles of files were supplied by the

archivist.
