Bio / Admin History: The Millet 4-H Garden Club was formed in 1964 or earlier and was still active in 1970. Its members were teen-aged girls in the vicinity of Millet, Alberta. They participated in a variety of social and educational activities. Clubs in the 4-H movement promoted good citizenship and development of agricultural and domestic skills among young people in rural areas of Alberta.

Custodial History: The fonds was donated by Alberta Agriculture, Wetaskiwin Office, in 1987 (Accession No. 87.53).
