- Bio / Admin History: John K. and Ellen (Ellis) Gray, from Kansas, homesteaded southwest of Millet, Alberta in 1900. They had eight children, Leonard, Hugh L., Robert M., Charles N., Percy N., Laura, Vale, and Leona. Leonard and his bride Enola Howard also homesteaded near his parents. Their children included Addie (Mrs. R. A. Wagner), Phoebe (Mrs. Victor Norquist), Jim, Bert, Dave, and Don Pearl (Mrs. Stan Scott), Bob, Howard, May (Mrs. Jim Ambrose), Nellie (Mrs. Alex Lawrence), Joy (Mrs. Phil McConnell) and Mrs. Shirley Ronaghan.
- Custodial History: The fonds was donated by R. A. Wagner (Accession No. 86.13), Alma (Mrs. Jim) Gray, and other family members.
