Bio/Admin History: The Millet and District Historical Society organized on November 30, 1976, and became a society of February 25, 1977. The first exhibit in partnership with CARMN was done in 1998. In 2011, the Historical Society began a permanent exhibit updated annually in honour of the women in the district of Millet who were active in the community.

Custodial History: The collection was gathered over 6 years for the Pioneer Women exhibit wall. The society collected biographical information, interviewed family members and friends, and copied photographs and objects. Over time further information and photographs have been offered to supplement those in the exhibit.

Scope/Content: The collection consists of photographs, oral histories, letters and correspondence with family and friends about each of the women. Related objects are in the museum objects collection.
