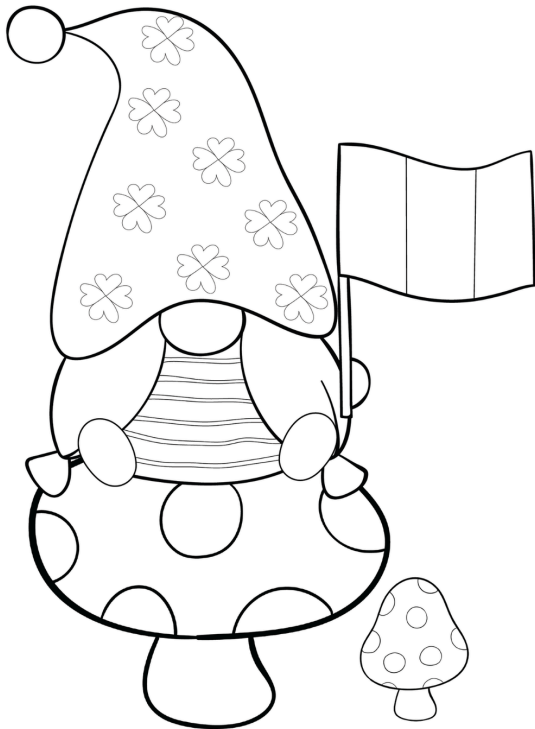


Leprechauns

Leprechauns are small elves or fairies from Irish folklore. Some stories say that leprechauns must grant you wishes if you catch them or that they must show you where they have hidden their gold. Others say that leprechauns hide their pots of gold at the end of the rainbow, so if you can find the end of a rainbow, you can find a pot of gold. This is why we use rainbows for St. Patrick's Day. In most stories, leprechauns disguise themselves as shoemakers. Leprechauns are usually described as mischievous; they use their magic to play tricks on people & to avoid being captured or to escape. We think of leprechauns as wearing green, but most stories described them as wearing red until the 1900s.
